ROLLING PROGRAMME FOR ENGLISH

Suggested Texts

The Junior children will largely be taught in mixed age groups of Years 3/4 and Years 5/6. The infants will be taught in a mixed aged group of Year 1 and 2. Within these grouping and sometimes as a whole class, the work will be differentiated, either by the specific task give; the levels of independence/support that are expected/given; the level of questioning and vocabulary used and/or the expectation of the work produced. Whilst each year focus in the rolling programme is directly linked to a particular age range, the expectations for each age group, including those working above, below or at expected levels will be maintained. The Juniors will work on a 4 year rolling programme and the Infants on a 2 year rolling programme.
