Multiplication Tables Check

This week the Year 4 pupils will complete the statutory Multiplication Tables Check (MTC).

There is no need for any worry — pupils have been working hard and making great progress with their TT Rock Stars practice.

The check consists of 25 timed questions assessing recall of times tables up to 12. This helps us identify anyone who may need extra support to secure this essential maths skill.

Phonics screening

The Phonics Screening Check for Year 1 will take place this week.

Each child reads 40 words one-to-one with a teacher in a short 5–10 minute session. This national assessment helps us identify children who may benefit from additional phonics support to ensure they continue to build strong early reading skills.

Life-Saving

As part of their swimming lessons over the next few weeks, Year 5 and 6 pupils will be practising life-saving skills. For these sessions, they will need to bring a pair of shorts and a T-shirt in addition to their usual swimming kit.

Forest School

Forest School will be on Friday this week instead of Wednesday and will be for Reception, and Year 1 and Year 2 pupils.

Please ensure children come dressed appropriately for outdoor learning.
